(Bettina jubilantly raps and/or sings a popular song about money. She knows all the words and has all the moves. She relishes every moment of this joyous victory)

I got on and they were like -(Pretending to be Sana and Adeel.) 'Here she is! Bettina, our queen! YassI Saved a seat for you. Come over, babes.' And this lady makes room on the seat next to her and has a go at Sana and Adeel. telling them they should be ashamed of themselves, and she'll call the police if they hassle me again, and how I'd be within my rights to call the police now if I wanted to, and maybe then they'd learn a lesson, because they obviously weren't learning anything at school And the whole bus was bare quiet, and this lady gave me a Polo, and when we got to my stop the bus driver made a big show of stopping for ages, and getting out of his seat to wave me off and making sure Sana and Adeel didn't follow me.

It just all came out, yeah? Everything they've pulled for the past...what? Two months? Torturing me. Making life like a living hell. So now I can start saving again and in a month I'll be able to bring Cardi home.

(Beat.)

I've got you to thank for this, you know?

No way I'd have been brave enough to do that if you hadn't prepped me.
